## **Statement Regarding COVID-19**

To our valued customers and students:

In May of 2020, driver education and driver training centers were deemed essential businesses by the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency, Department of Homeland Security.

In line with that essential designation, we are remaining open and continuing to conduct courses, at this time.

We have implemented and are following the guidelines provided by the World Health Organization, the United States Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and the California Department of Public Health (CDPH). Based off of these guidelines, we have instituted the following protocols:

For our Students:

- All students will complete a brief health questionnaire before the beginning of each lesson.
- All students will have their temperature taken, via infrared, no-touch thermometer before each lesson. Any student showing a reading of 100.4°F or higher will not be allowed to take their lesson and will need to be rescheduled.
- All students will wear a facemask, covering the total area from the bridge of their nose to the tip of their chin, during the entire 2 hours of each driving lesson.
- All students will be required to clean their hands with hand sanitizer (provided by A1 Driving School, Inc.) before the start of each lesson.
- Any student who is feeling sick or showing flu-like symptoms will not be allowed to take their lesson. They will need to contact our office immediately, so that their lesson(s) may be rescheduled.
- Any student whose lesson is cancelled for health reasons will be rescheduled no sooner than 18 days after their original appointment date and no fever or flu-like symptoms are present.

Students failing to comply with these requirements will be not be allowed to take their driving lesson until compliance is met.

For our Staff:

1. We have increased the frequency of our cleaning procedures of all high touch point areas in our office and in all of our vehicles.
2. We are scheduling lesson times, to ensure that there is extra time in between students to completely disinfect the vehicle.
3. We have directed our instructors to increase the frequency of their hand washing and personal disinfecting.
4. We are requiring our instructors to wear facemasks during lessons. These items will be safely disposed of immediately following each lesson and fresh equipment will be in place, being worn, in time for the next student.

The overall protection of our staff, our instructors and our students has been at the center of what we do for over 27 years. As such, we would like to continue to assure you that we are taking every available precautionary measure to ensure that we are continuing to do so, as we continue to deal with the COVID-19 situation, together.
